THE SHORTER PROPHETS

The last part of the Old Testament comprises 12 short books written by prophets, spaced out over many centuries. Confusingly, they are not in chronological order, so we will try to relate each one to the books of Kings and Chronicles, so that we can see how their message was appropriate to the period.
